**Wed 14<sup>th</sup> Oct 2020**



You will be truly captivated by the one million hectares of tall forests that appear to stretch forever, sandstone cliffs, canyons and waterfalls that make up the magnificent Blue Mountains World Heritage Area.

Our journey begins as we head south stopping en route for morning tea.

The first point of interest will be a lovely light lunch at the **Norman Lindsay Museum and Gallery Café** before we are taken on a guided tour of this heritage-listed former residence and farmlet. A controversial artist and author in his time, Norman Lindsay's home now serves as a gallery of his many works. His paintings adorn the walls and his sculptures can be found in the beautiful gardens, including characters from the children's classic "The Magic Pudding."

As we make our way to our accommodation we will make one more stop to **The Gingerbread House and Store** which is set in a beautifully restored 100year old former church in Katoomba. Here you will have time to ponder the store or satisfy your sweet urge by indulging in a Ginger beer float, spider, ice-cream, Josophan's Fine drinking chocolates & cakes, and let's not forget house baked gingerbread (own expense). We spend the next 2 nights in the **Carrington Hotel** which is a heritage listed hotel and a local landmark offering the elegance, luxury & charm of yesteryear. Dinner tonight will be at our Hotel.

## Day 2: The Best of the Blue Mountains (B, MT, AT, D) Thur 15<sup>th</sup> Oct 2020

Pack your camera's, today we are going to show case the Blue mountains in all its beauty.

We begin the day touring in the comfort of our coach as we make our way to **Eagle Hawke Lookout, Narrow Neck Lookout and Echo Point (Three sisters)**, which is one of the most visited sites in the Blue Mountains. These dramatic rock formations watch over the land of the traditional country of the Darug, Gundungurra, Wiradjuri and Dharwal Aboriginal people. According to one Aboriginal legend, the pillars were once three beautiful sisters named Meehni, Wimlah and Gunnedoo who were turned into stone by a powerful tribal elder.

We will stop for morning tea at the beautiful **Cascade Picnic area** before heading to the **Leuralla Toy and Railway Museum**.

You will have some free time in **Leura** where you can enjoy lunch (own expense) and browse pretty tree-lined streets, galleries and boutiques.

Now, don't fill up too much, because this afternoon we will make our way up the mountain to enjoy the Magical views from the recently restored **Hydro Majestic for a Winter Garden High Tea experience**. The views from the historic hotel stretch along the escarpment edge, overlooking the picturesque Megalong Valley. Dinner tonight will be at our Hotel.



## Day 3: Scenic World to Tuncurry (B) Friday 16<sup>th</sup> Oct 2020

A trip to the Blue Mountains wouldn't be complete without calling into **Scenic World** at Katoomba. Here you can ride the Scenic Skyway gondola across Jamison Valley, taking in views of the Three Sisters, Mount Solitary and Katoomba Falls. Scenic World is also home to the Scenic Railway, the world's steepest incline railway, descending more than 400 metres down the escarpment. Be sure to grab yourself some lunch during your stay here today before we begin our journey home, having experienced the Blue Mountains and all its beauty.
