Day 1: Tuncurry to Coffs Harbour (L, D)

Fri 5th Nov 2021

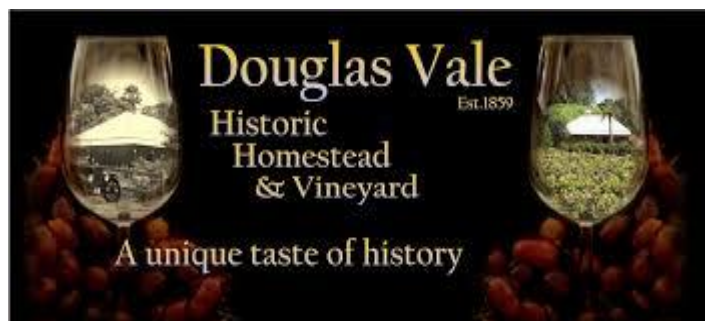
