DAY 1: Tuesday 22nd Feb 2022 **Travel Day Forster/Tuncurry to Yamba** **(L, D)**

Our final leg of the journey will have us arriving at **Yamba**, home of the famous Yamba Prawn and stunning beaches, positioned at the mouth of the Clarence River.

Summerland Farm is a beautiful macadamia and avocado farm set high in the Ballina-Byron hinterland. After lunch we head to the **Ballina Maritime Museum** which showcases the original Las Balsas Raft, Port Of Ballina and local history, interactive maritime displays, the largest collection of Naval and Merchant Ships in Australia, tribute to women in the Navy, a working steam engine, Historical Ballina river boats and tugs and a Souvenir and gift shop. Before settling in to our accommodation for the night we will tour Ballina's township and Beaches.

DAY 4: Friday 26th Feb 2022 Tweed Valley Adventures

Not too far up the road, we continue our journey today inching closer to the Queensland border making our first stop at **Zentvelds Coffee Farm and Roasters in Newrybar**. After a tour of the plantation and time to enjoy a cup of their famous coffee, we travel on hugging the coastline viewing the seaside towns of **Lennox Head, Broken head, Suffolk park** enroute to **Byron Bay**. We will make a trip up to Cape Byron Lighthouse which was built at the turn of the 19th century to protect ships passing along the coast. Cape Byron Lighthouse stands resolute on the most easterly point of Australia's mainland. Then its time to soak up some **Free time in the hippie precinct of Byron Bay** where you can relish in the many coffee shops, restaurants and boutique shops. (Lunch today will be at your own expense). An additional option will be provided for those that wish to participate in a tasting tour at the **Stone and Wood Brewery** while others continue lapping up the relaxing atmosphere of Bryon Bay. As we board the coach at the end of our day we make our final stop at Tweed Heads where we will spend the next 3 nights.

After lunch we head to **Tweed Valley Farmhouse Cheeses** in Burringbar where we be spoilt with a platter from their four generation family run dairy. As we make our way back through the Valley we turn off at Pottsville to tour the coast road back through, Hastings Point, Casuarina, Salt Village and Kingscliff.

On this scenic Sunday session river cruise down the Tweed River to Tumbulgum, you will be transported to **Husk Distillery** for 1.5 hours. Your table awaits you with a **tasting paddle of Gin or Rum and a trio of dips and pita bread** to indulge in while you take in the ambience of the Tweeds most famous Gin Distillery. You will then be transported back to the boat where you will sail into a Tweed River **indulgence of our famous locally sourced charcuterie board with fresh trawler prawns, local oysters and green salad**. Relax on the top deck of the river cruiser while sipping a cocktail, wine or beer and take in the breath taking views of the mighty Tweed Valley and Tweed River while listening to great music.
