Day 1: Monday 28th March

(MT, L, D)

Our journey to the stunning countryside of Orange begins as we make our way towards the Blue Mountains, stopping for morning tea along the way. Joining the Bells Line of Road, we will travel through to the Bilpin Fruit bowl for lunch. After lunch we head west towards Orange where we will check in to our accommodation for the next 3 nights. The hotel is situated in the heart of orange and very close to the shopping precinct.

Day 2: Tuesday 29th March

(B, MT, A/T, D)

Following a hearty breakfast, we are joined on the coach by a locally based guide who will deliver a tour of the town. Orange has some of the richest and most beautiful agricultural land in the country. Our morning stop will also include Mount Canobolas for a panoramic view of the surrounding region. Mount Canobolas is an extinct volcano encircled by a nature reserve rich in native fauna. It is the highest point between the Blue Mountains and the Indian Ocean so the views are superb. Following our guided tour we will then head to the Orange Information centre where we will have a bush tucker morning tea presented by a local indigenous gentleman.

Free time in town today will allow you to purchase some lunch (own expense). Our afternoon will begin with a visit to the Agrestic Grocer which is housed in a semi-industrial straw-bale/brick building. The Agrestic Grocer provides a unique shopping and dining experience with fresh local produce and a selection of local wines, and a brewery.

Our afternoon tea will be at a local Fig farm with a talk and taste.

Day 3: Wednesday 30th March

(B, M/T, L, D)

This morning we head to Manildra which is home to the Manildra Flour Mill, one of the largest in the southern hemisphere and is now the home to Australia's oldest operational picture theatre, Amusu Theatre. A film will be shown with time to also visit the Poster Museum with hundreds of original movie posters. Continuing on, we travel into the old world charm of Molong, where we will stop in at the Molong Yarn Market and view the famous tapestry created by the people of Molong before enjoying a light lunch. We end the day with a visit to Banjo Patterson park with nine sculptures to enjoy and a walk along the banks of the Buckinbah Creek.

Day 4: Thursday 31st March

(B, L, D)

Today we leave orange and our sightseeing takes us to Huntley Berry Farm to sample or purchase the local spreads, jams and oil that are all locally produced. Our next stop is the small town of Millthorpe, which was established in the pioneering era. The entire village is classified by the National Trust and its centre has cobbled, bluestone bordered streets. On arrival you will have some free time to wander around the quaint little town before meeting back at the Golden Memories Museum. The museum displays a wonderful array of old time memorabilia which has been collected and conserved. The museum contains district records, artefacts, farm equipment, family history and photographs which have been collected over the past 45 years. Lunch will be enjoyed on the grounds of the Museum today. We make our way to Bathurst for our last night on tour. This evening, we have a very unique and elegant night out at Abercrombie House which was built in the 1870's. The home contains some 40 rooms and the beautiful gardens are listed as part of the national estate. Tonight, we are in for a treat in the style of "Downton Abbey" where we will



enjoy a formal dinner from the age of elegance in the Reign of George V. In the ambience of the old days, we'll have pre-dinner drinks in the Drawing Room followed by a grand 3 course dinner including complimentary drinks and table wines in the Ballroom. Our dinner will be themed to reflect the magnificent Georgian era with lots of reference to the life and character of grand country houses of the era. Lively entertainment will round

off a wonderful and memorable evening. Please bring your tiara or top hat and bow tie as we will be able to dress up and join in.

Day 5: Friday 01 April

(B, MT, L)

Following breakfast, we farewell Bathurst and start to make our way home, our first stop this morning will be at the Blue mountains Botanical Garden for some morning tea and a wander through the gardens. We continue our journey homeward with lunch along the way. This afternoon sit back and relax as we express for home arriving with many wonderful memories of our 5 day holiday.
