Day 1: (D) TUNCURRY TO SYDNEY

Sunday 27 October 2024

Welcome to our 11 day Discover Perth Tour. This morning we will make our way to Sydney Airport, where we settle in for 1 night prior to flying out tomorrow morning. A welcome dinner with your new travel companions will be enjoyed on our first night at our accommodation.

Day 2: (BD) SYDNEY TO PERTH

Monday 28 October 2024

This morning after an early start we will be transferred to the Sydney Airport for our flight on to Perth. On arrival in Perth our local touring company will be waiting to greet us. After we are all on board, sit back and enjoy the ride as we make our way to our hotel located at Scarborough Beach for the next 4 nights. It will be an ideal place from which we can enjoy visiting the local sights in Perth and our Wildflowers sightseeing later in the week.

Day 3: (BLD) ROTTNEST ISLAND

Tuesday 29 October 2024

Today we visit **Rottnest Island**. Located just off the coast in the warm clear waters of the Indian Ocean, Rottnest Island is a spectacular world of white sandy beaches with crystal clear blue waters and an abundance of wildlife. We explore the beauty and tranquility of Rottnest with a ferry transfer, guided coach tour and a delicious lunch. After a full day on the Island, we return to our Perth hotel to relax before dinner. Day 4: (BD) PERTH DISCOVERY

Wednesday 30 October 2024

Today we enjoy a guided tour of Perth. We'll see the new Elizabeth Quay, named in honour of Queen Elizabeth II. We also see Parliament House, Government House and Barrack Arch, finishing our sightseeing at the **Perth Mint**. The building features the original Melt House where gold was melted and made into coins. A gold pour will be conducted for us in the same way it was when the building was first constructed. We now head to the parklands for spectacular views over the city and river from **Kings Park**; hopefully we may see some wildflowers! Next, we head straight to historical **Fremantle**. Fremantle, of course, was the port from where the first team outside the USA to win the America's Cup was from – the cup being held in "Freo" meant that a lot of love and attention was given to the well-preserved architectural heritage, including convict-built colonial-era buildings, an old jetty and port and prisons; presenting a variety and unity of historic buildings and streetscapes. We take a look around before checking in at the **Little Creatures Brewery** for a tasting ending a most eventful day of touring.

Day 5: (BD) LESUEUR & THE PINNACLES

Thursday 31 October 2024

This morning we make our way to **Cervantes** taking the newly opened scenic drive - Indian Ocean Road. We arrive in time for a lunch break (*own expense*) before our arrival at the **Lesueur National Park**. Lesueur National Park is a must see for all wildflower lovers and botanists with more than 900 species of flora identified within the park. A sealed loop road drive circles the park and the main car park adjacent to Mount Lesueur offers a magnificent panoramic view across the park and the pretty coastlines of Jurien Bay and Green Head. Next, we visit the **Nambung National Park** – home to the **Pinnacles**. This unique landscape of limestone pillars is like a moon scene, strange looking formations rising eerily out of the sand. We return to **Perth** where we enjoy dinner in our hotel. Breakfast and dinner in hotel, lunch own expense and arrangements



Day 6: (BLD) BUNBURY AND BUSSELTON

Friday 01 November 2024

The next stage of our tour has us heading to the south western corner of Australia. We follow the coast road through Rockingham, arriving in **Mandurah** late morning. Here we board Mandurah Cruises and as we glide through the calm inland waterways of the Mandurah Estuary and the Peel Inlet, we can enjoy a delicious fish & chip lunch. Known for the friendly wild dolphins, hopefully we'll see some playing in the wake of our vessel. This afternoon, we continue south through **Bunbury** then onto **Busselton** where we can see the famous Busselton Jetty.

Day 7: (BLD) MARGARET RIVER & CAPE LEEUWIN

Saturday 02 November 2024

We have an early start this morning so we can explore the Margaret River area. This area is a rich dairy cattle and timber region, with a reputation for fine wines and surfing. This morning we drive south along the scenic **Caves Road** which will take us past the actual Margaret River mouth to **Mammoth Cave**. After a guided tour here, we travel to **Cape Leeuwin** for a drive past and photo opportunity of the historic Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse, situated at the most south westerly tip of Australia, standing at the point where the Indian and Southern Oceans meet. The awesome force of the fierce Southern Ocean and powerful Indian Ocean crashing against the Cape makes a visit to the Cape a unique experience. Lunch is served at **Cheeky Monkey Brewing Co** where a beer tasting is also on offer. No visit to the region would be complete without a wine tasting which we enjoy at **Aravina Estate**. On our way back to Busselton we visit the **Margaret River Chocolate Factory** where we have a fascinating insight into the world of chocolate. The Margaret River

Chocolate Company makes and sells a mouth-watering range of chocolate bars, chocolate coated delights, handmade truffles, novelty chocolates, chocolate sauces and much more.

Day 8: (BD) BUSSELTON TO PERTH

Sunday 03 November 2024

This morning after checking out of our hotel, enjoy some free time exploring the township of **Margaret River**. Wander through the streets and shops before arriving late morning in **Bunbury** at the **Dolphin Discovery Centre**. Enjoy lunch (own expense) followed by a one and half hour cruise within Koombana Bay. We can look through the centre on our return, then continue our journey to **Perth** where we enjoy dinner in our hotel.
